LINE CONCENTRATOR-IDENTIFIER (J93021) APPLIED TO TELEPHONE SECRETARIAL ANSWERING SERVICE CIRCUIT TESTS AND TROUBLE ANALYSIS

1. GENERAL

1.01 This section is issued to advise central office personnel where routine maintenance information covering the line concentrator-identifier (J93021), when applied to the telephone secretarial answering service, can be found. This information is contained in Section 473-501-501, Issue 3 and Addendum 1 which describes the circuit tests required to test the line concentrator-identifier and trouble analysis to assist if trouble conditions occur.

- 1.02 Whenever Section 473-501-501 is reissued, the reason for its reissue will be listed in this paragraph. This issue does not affect the Equipment Test List.
- 1.03 The concentrator-identifier system consists of two units interconnected with two, four, or six talking trunks and a maximum of four signaling pairs. The originating equipment (concentrator) is located in the central office and the terminating equipment (identifier) is located at the Telephone (Secretarial) Answering Service location.
