




Cam Cleaner. For use on 155A interrupters and A-and B-type and spring driven sequence switches.






Portable Plug Cleaner. Consists of a bracket with an insulated, tapered pin for holding a cleaning cord and centering the plugs, a P-243641 hank (48 feet) of four solid braid white cotton cord, and two wood cord adjusting balls. For use in conjunction with the 385B and 385C tools in cleaning plugs.



Plug Chucks. These tools are for use in conjunction with the 384A tool for holding plugs while cleaning. The 385B tool is for holding 137-, 152-, and 289-type plugs; and the 385C tool is for holding 309- and 310-type plugs.



Plug Chucks. Consist of two jaws hinged at one end and fastened by means of a screw with a handle ε^+ the other end. For use in conjunction with the 384A tool for holding 396A plugs while cleaning.






Bank Contact Cleaner. Replaces the 402C tool. For use in cleaning the contacts of 200-point banks of 197-type switches.




Bench Fixture. For use in holding rotor hubs of 200-, 206-, 209-, and 211-type selectors and 25-point rotary switches while cleaning.
