D PLASTIC ANCHOR


1. GENERAL

1.01 D plastic anchors equipped with wood screws are intended for making indoor or outdoor attachments to masonry surfaces.




Outdoor use requires a galvanized wood screw.

1.02 These anchors are available in three sizes and four designs (Fig. 1, 2, 3, and 4).










1.03 Table A contains anchor size number, length, and diameter of anchors and required wood screw.




Fig. 5 — Installation

2. INSTALLATION (Fig. 5)

- 2.01 The anchors required a predrilled hole. The diameter and depth of the predrilled hole should correspond with the diameter and length of the anchor sleeve. (See Table A.)
 - A Insert anchor into the drilled hole tapping it lightly until the head is flush with the mounting surface.



B — Insert RH wood screw through the mounting hole of fixture into the anchor and turn it down until it seats firmly.
