V4 TELEPHONE REPEATER

1. GENERAL

Issue 1 of the section is gradually becoming obsolete as a source of descriptive information about V4 repeaters, as explained below. As soon as it is completely obsolete, it will be canceled. In the meantime, please look first for any information about V4 repeaters and plug-in units in the subdivisions of sections listed in Part 2. Information in those subdvisions supersedes any conflicting information in Section 332-104-100.

1.02 When Section 332-104-100 was issued in 1962, it described all the repeater shelves and plug-in amplifiers, networks, equalizers, and terminating sets then available. When additional kinds of these units started to enter the picture, it seemed impracticable to keep such an all-inclusive section up to date. It was decided, therefore, to issue a separate, easily revisable

section about each shelf and plug-in component. A number of the sections needed for replacing Section 332-104-100 have already been issued, and the rest are nearing completion.
