1. GENERAL

1.001 This addendum supplements Practice 400-520-103, Issue 3. Place this pink sheet ahead of Page 1 of the Practice.

1.002 This addendum is issued to add information on Nature-of-Application codes to paragraphs 2.20 and 2.22.

2. CHANGES TO PRACTICE

2.001 On Page 8, change paragraph 2.20 and the heading above that paragraph as follows.

Coverage of Construction Permit in Full (LF) in Conjunction With Codes MC, MD, MR, or MM in any Combination Entered in Item 2(d)

If the application is to cover a construction 2.20 permit/modified construction permit in full (code LF) and if notification is being provided of changes covered by codes MC, MD, MM, or MR, complete Items 6 through 9 only insofar as concerns codes MC, MD, and MR. Instructions for completing Items 6 through 9 covering codes MD, MR, and MC are contained in paragraphs 2.23-2.24, 2.25, and 2.26, respectively, of this Practice. Paragraph 2.27 of this Practice provides instructions for completing FCC Form 436 when code MM is entered in Item 2(d). Under Item 12 (Remarks) of FCC Form 436, identify and explain the changes/corrections covered by codes MC, MD, MM, and MR.

There is no change to Notes 1 and 2 of paragraph 2.20.

2.002 On Page 9, change paragraph 2.22 and the heading above that paragraph as follows.

Coverage of Construction Permit in Part (LP) in Conjunction With Codes MC, MD, MR, or MM in any Combination Entered in Item 2(d)

2.22 If the application is to cover a construction permit/modified construction permit in part (code LP) and if notification is being provided of changes covered by codes MC, MD, MM, or MR, complete Items 6 through 9 for that part being covered in the same manner in which the original application was completed. Alter the data on the partial coverage to reflect changes/corrections covered by codes MC, MD, and MR. In addition and if applicable, complete Items 6 through 9 to reflect those MC, MD, or MR changes that apply to the station but which do not directly relate to the construction authority being covered. Instructions for completing Items 6 through 9 covering codes MD, MR, and MC are contained in paragraphs 2.23-2.24, 2.25, and 2.26, respectively, of this Practice. Paragraph 2.27 of this Practice provides instructions for completing FCC Form 436 when code MM is entered in Item 2(d). Under Item 12 (Remarks) of FCC Form 436, identify and explain the changes/corrections covered by codes MC, MD, MM, and MR. (See Notes 1 and 2 in paragraph 2.20.)
