
## MARKING PHYSICAL LOCATION OF STATION EQUIPMENT AND CABLE

## 1. GENERAL

- 1.01 This Section replaces Section 460-110-130.
- 1.02 This Section:
  - (a) Introduces the use of Form SW-6497, a red and white write-on Station Location Sticker (see Figure 1).
  - (b) Describes the use of the form to show the physical location of key telephone apparatus and equipment.

## 2. FORM SW-6497, STATION LOCATION STICKER


- 2.01 This Station Location Sticker, used when pre-surveying, is a self-adhesive label with a peel-off backing which separates into three parts (see Figure 1).
  - (a) When pre-surveying, the foreman should peel the narrow top and bottom strips off the sticker when placing it to mark a station location. He should then write the KTS number, the station number and the location of the equipment (see Figure 1) on the sticker.
  - (b) After installation, the installer should remove the sticker, peel off the remainder of the backing, and place the sticker on the bottom of the telephone set (see Figure 2).




Form SW-6497, Station Location Sticker (3 3/4" x 2") FIGURE 1

- 2.02 The Station Location Sticker is commonly used to:
  - (a) Direct installation and maintenance forces to the location of the terminal points and equipment (see Figures 2 and 3).

- (b) Mark locations for telephones and equipment when pre-surveying new installations.
- (c) Mark desks when rearranging telephone sets or lines.
