BURIED SERVICE - DROP PROTECTION

## 1. GENERAL .

1.01 This section describes procedures to be followed by Plant field forces when establishing telephone service for customers upon whose premises buried service wire is utilized.

1.02 On all new installations and/or reinstallations where buried service wire is used, it is necessary to inform the customer of certain precautions that should be taken whenever "digging operations" are contemplated on the premises. Principal precautions are:

- (a) The presence of buried wire beneath the surface of the premises.
- (b) General location, i.e., front or rear of customer's premises.
- (c) The possibility of any "digging operations" in the vicinity of such buried telephone wire jeopardizing the customer's service.
- (d) The Southwestern Company's willingness, upon request, to send an employee to the customer's premises to show where the buried service wire crosses the premises so it can be avoided during digging operations. Be sure to point out that "No Charge" (i.e., customer <u>is not</u>

<u>billed</u>) is applicable for such service calls or the premise visits.

1.03 Information pamphlet Form SW-6426 entitled "Before You Dig Please Call Us" should be given to each customer, when telephone service is initially established, whose telephone service utilizes buried service wire on his premises. See Exhibit 1. This attractive pamphlet briefly explains the benefits of buried underground cable, also how and where to call before digging to avoid interrupting telephone service due to a cut cable.
