
EXTENSION CORDS AND PHONEMOUNT IDENTIFICATION



EXTENSION OF SERVICE ARRANGEMENTS CUSTOMER PARTICIPATION PRODUCTS

1. GENERAL

- 1.01 This section provides information on the H4EN 12-foot retractile modular handset cord, the D4CE 25-foot modular extension mounting cord, and the 730A connecting block (Phonemount).
- 1.02 Whenever this section is reissued, the reason(s) for reissue will be listed in this paragraph.
- 1.03 The extension cords and Phonemount will be packaged in special designed blister-type packages with all necessary hardware and instructions either in or on the package. They will be distributed to the customer from Bell retail outlets such as PhoneCenter Stores, Bell Customer Service Centers, or Bell Phone Booths.

2. IDENTIFICATION




Fig. 1—H4EN Handset Cord

2.01 H4EN Handset Cord (Fig. 1): The H4EN handset cord is a modular retractile 12-foot decorator-type handset cord covered with a brown cotton braid. It is intended for use with the

COUNTRY JUNCTION* telephone where a long handset cord is desired.

extension cord is a 25-foot 4-conductor polyvinylchloride (PVC) jacketed mounting cord. It is available in ivory (-50) and brown (-104) colors. It has a modular plug on one end and a modular jack on the other end and is intended to allow a customer to extend telephone service from a working modular connecting block to a different location in the same room.

2.03 Phonemount — 730A Connecting Block (Fig. 3): The 730A connecting block consists of a 630A connecting block with a permanently attached 6-foot mounting cord and modular plug. In the package there will be two molly-type screws and two panhead wood screws, either pair of which are to be used to mount the connecting block base to the wall depending on the mounting surface. A stainless steel faceplate covers the base and is fastened with two small machine screws. The customer plugs the cord directly or through an extension cord into a working modular connecting block and mounts a portable modular wall telephone on the Phonemount.




Fig. 2—D4CE Extension Cord




Fig. 3—730A Connecting Block Package
