3. ORDERING GUIDE

- 3.01 Order as follows:
 - Reel, Cord, 2B
 - Reel, Cord, 3B
 - Reel, Cord, 3C
 - Reel, Cord, 5A
 - ▶Reel, Cord, 5C◆
- 3.02 ♦The 2A (MD), 2C (MD), and 3A (MD) cord reels are replaced by the 2B, 3C, and 3B respectively. The 5B is also MD with no replacement. •

4. DESIGN FEATURES

4.01 2B Cord Reel:

• 5-1/2 foot usable length KS-20219L1 cord

- For use with G-type handset
- Various mounting arrangements
- Split grommet and nut for use in cord entrance hole or mounting panel.

4.02 3B Cord Reel:

- 5-1/2 foot usable length KS-20219L1 cord
- For use with G3-type handset
- Mounts flat to surface.
- 4.03 3C Cord Reel: Same as for 3A and 3B cord reels, except for use with TRIMLINE telephone set or telephone sets equipped with the G12A handset. Equipped with a H4DE cord.

4.04 5A Cord Reel:

- 6 foot usable length H4DY cord
- For use with G15A or K1A handset
- Similar to 3-type reel except 1-inch smaller in diameter.

4.05 \$5C Cord Reel:

- 6-foot usable length
- Similar to 5A cord reel except equipped with a H4EF cord
- For use with 911A1 and 2911A1 DESIGN LINE telephone sets
- Latch mechanism prevents retraction of cord during usage, latch is released on second pull of cord.




Fig. 1—♦2B Cord Reel♦




Fig. 2—♦3B Cord Reel♦





Fig. 3—♦3C Cord Reel4






Fig. 4-5A Cord Reel
