- Add information on clear transparent window forms.

Since this section covers a general revision, arrows ordinarily used to indicate changes have been omitted.

2. IDENTIFICATION

2.01 Table A lists the recommended replacements for the old forms.


2.02 The new forms are perforated on continuous clear acetate without preprinted information, therefore it is necessary to order an appropriate station number card form. Refer to Section 501-150-100 for additional information.

- 2.03 Forms are ordered by the package, with 1000 cards per package.
- 2.04 Order as follows;

Note: This form is used with rotary dial equipped telephone sets.

(b) (Quantity) Form E-10375

Note: This form is used with TOUCH-TONE[®] dial equipped sets.






Fig. 1—New Transparent Windows
