# CALL DIRECTOR® TELEPHONE SETS SELECTION

### 1. GENERAL

1.01 This section is intended for use as an aid in the selection of a CALL DIRECTOR type telephone set from the codes available, according to the customer's service requirements.

- 1.02 This section is reissued to revise Tables A, B, C, and D.
- 1.03 Structure of the coding series is as follows:
  - (a) The first three digits (rotary sets) or first four digits (TOUCH-TONE<sup>®</sup> sets) of the code identify the intended functions of each type of set.
  - (b) The first numerical suffix denotes the complete sequence of keys or options on the front panel.

1.04 For information on the special service options available for CALL DIRECTOR type sets, refer to section in Division 502 entitled 630-, 1630-, and 2630-Series Telephone Sets, Common Installation and Maintenance Information.
