## 2662AIM TELEPHONE SETS

## 1. GENERAL

1.01 This section contains identification information for the 2662A1M telephone sets (Fig. 1 and 2). The 2662 A 1 M telephone sets are modular, desk-type, card dialer, 6 -button key sets equipped with a 12 -button TOUCH-TONE ${ }^{\ominus}$ dial which provides for automatic and manual calling.

1.03 These sets are designed for use in 1A, 1A1, 1A2, or 6A key telephone systems. They are equipped for 5 -line pickup and hold on central office, PBX, and private or intercommunicating lines.
1.04 These sets can be arranged to accommodate an 819040122 (P-90D012) polarity guard to provide for end-to-end signaling (Fig. 3).

2.03 The 2662A1M telephone set is equipped with a 635A5 key, KS-20419L1 (10 volt ac only) buzzer and 36E dial.
2.04 The 36 E dial consists of a mechanical card reader and a 35 -type TOUCH-TONE dial, combined as a unit. The card reader uses the electrical circuitry of the 35-type dial for multifrequency signaling.
2.05 The 36 E dial is operated by inserting a coded card in the card slot and depressing the START bar. The card is fed past the reader mechanism and the coded portion of the card causes two sets of contacts to close for each digit. This function is equivalent to depressing a button on the TOUCH-TONE dial.
2.06 Two 812167526 (P-21F752) card sets, each containing twenty code cards and one 811353630 (P-13E363) card index set consisting of nine alphabetical spacer cards, are furnished with each set.


## Optional Features

2.07 The M1B ringer can be used as a common audible signal or an individual line ringer. Ringer volume is adjustable by use of the volume control (accessible from the bottom of the set). Ringer cut off can be provided by removal of the volume control stop screw through an access hole in the base of the set.
2.08 A KS-8109L2 buzzer (ordered separately) can be mounted on the network, using the spacer and screw provided, for use as an auxiliary signal.
