PACKAGED KEY TELEPHONE UNITS

1A1 AND 6A

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

1.00 GENERAL

- 1.01 This section provides information for the identification and description of the 1A1 and 6A key telephone unit packages.
- 1.02 Packaged key telephone units are made up of individual panel-type key telephone units mounted and factory-wired on various size apparatus mountings.
- 1.03 These packages are available with or without an associated cable tail, terminated on connecting blocks on one end and on the key telephone unit terminals on the other.
- 1.04 The packages provide the basic requirements for 1A1 and 6A key telephone equipment installations. They are ordered as a complete unit by using the appropriate code number. Additional features required to fit the needs of a particular installation may be added locally.
- 1.05 Some of the advantages of the packaged units are:
 - Improved public relations due to simplified installations.
 - Building block arrangements for future growth.
 - Simplified ordering of equipment.
 - Ready recognition, by standard codes, thus expediting procurement, handling, and accounting for these units.

2.00 DESCRIPTION

2.01 There are three basic types of 1A1 and selector-only 6A key telephone unit packages. These are coded 200F, 200G, and 200K. The

basic differences in these packages are the capacities of the apparatus mountings upon which the equipment is mounted. The 200F, 200G, and 200K packages are equipped with a 232B KTU which includes the KS-15900, List 1 interrupter.

- 2.02 The 200H package is a basic 2-link, 6A dial selective intercom system. This package is equipped with a 232B KTU which does not include the KS-15900, List 1 interrupter. If the KS-15900, List 1 interrupter is required, it must be ordered separately.
- 2.03 A description of the key telephone unit codes, service features, apparatus mountings, and cable terminals is shown in Table A.
- 2.04 For more detailed information, descriptions, and photographs refer to the Sections covering the 200F, 200G, 200K, and 200H key telephone units.

3.00 HANDLING OF 1A1 AND 6A KEY TELEPHONE UNITS PACKAGES

Wire spring relays are used almost exclusively in the above named packages. These relays will not withstand rough or unusual handling, especially without adequate packing protection. Therefore, the following rules should apply when transporting and handling package units:

- Follow directions printed on cartons.
- Do not drop cartons.
- Ship in suitable cartons, adequately packed.
- When practicable the entire package, including cable tail, should be recovered and securely packed.
